On June 30, 2017, the Ashland County Community Foundation completed its 22nd year of operation, and what an “empowering” year it’s been!

With much thanks to those that support ACCF, with a philanthropic spirit that is unique for a community our size, we continue to make great strides in impacting our community in a positive way.

Those of us who have served as trustees, volunteers or staff are amazed at the rate of growth that ACCF has experienced. Few of us could have envisioned, at this point in our history, having 390 endowment funds under administration, with \$44 million in assets and the awarding of over \$11 million in scholarships and grants.

This growth has allowed our donors to feel empowered, as they witness their gifts making a difference in the lives of those with needs in Ashland County.

Students pursuing higher education are empowered by the prospect of having someone who doesn’t even know them being willing to invest in their future through ACCF’s scholarship program.

Our Women’s Fund provides a grantmaking framework for women to empower other women.

Non-profit agencies are experiencing the empowerment of knowing that sustainability can exist for their respective organizations through the strength of endowment-building.

At ACCF, a special youth envoy has been empowered through participation in our IMPACT Youth Council, where they have become grantmakers, furthering empowering other young people in Ashland County, by providing much-needed support for youth-oriented programs and initiatives.

So, endowment = empowerment.

Empowering others through the creation of endowment is why a community foundation exists. Our donors become enablers of progress in our community.

Your Community Foundation



The Ashland County Community Foundation is among more than 750 community foundations in the United States. Community foundations are tax-exempt, 501(c)(3) public charities that serve local donors who wish to take an organized approach to giving. Because community foundations are public charities, their donors enjoy increased tax advantages not available to private foundation donors. Community foundation donors also receive professional support without hiring staff. Unlike private foundations, community foundations invest and administer a pool of funds contributed by numerous donors. Together, these donors create an endowment - in essence the community's charitable savings account - designed to ensure the long-term health of the nonprofit community.

Ohio is home to more than 90 community foundations, including several recognized nationwide as innovators in the field. Individually and collectively they provide Ohio with a wealth of energy, ideas, leadership, and social and philanthropic capital. These resources help find new and effective solutions to the challenges facing our communities. Community foundations, in essence, represent trust and confidence in the community and a commitment to our future.

Like all community foundations, the Ashland County Community Foundation:

- Has an independent, all-volunteer governing body broadly representative of its community.
- Informs and educates individuals, families and businesses about community issues and grant making opportunities.
- Actively involves individuals, families and businesses in identifying and responding to community issues and opportunities.
- Keeps all information obtained with respect to donors, funds and prospects for new fund creation confidential to the fullest extent possible.
- Honors the charitable intentions of its donors consistent with community needs and applicable laws and regulations.
- Is a steward of charitable funds, investing and prudently managing funds and maintaining accurate financial records, and is accountable to its community and regularly disseminates information on its programs and finances.
- Ensures that its financial resources are used solely in furtherance of its mission.

Donors who give through the Ashland County Community Foundation enjoy the satisfaction of knowing that their gifts will be safely and efficiently administered for the charitable purposes they specify, as well as receiving the maximum tax deduction for their contributions.



YOUTH PHILANTHROPY

IMPACT Youth Council

I-M-P-A-C-T is an acronym for “Imagine Making Philanthropy an Ashland County Tradition” and is the branding for a new group of high school-aged grantmakers that we call our ACCF IMPACT Youth Council. The IMPACT Youth Council is ACCF’s newest program, providing a community service opportunity for sophomores, juniors and seniors from Ashland, Hillsdale, Loudonville and Mapleton high schools, the Ashland County-West Holmes Career Center and Home Schoolers.

2017 Young “Difference-Makers”

ACCF’s Young “Difference-Makers” Program (formerly Kids Who Care) recognizes individuals or groups of young people, ages 5 to 18 in Ashland County, who have initiated activities and/or programs from the heart, impacting others in profound and meaningful ways.

IMPACT Youth Grants 14 grants awarded in 2016-2017 totaling \$13,365.30

IMPACT Youth Grants are awarded to 501(c)(3) and other qualifying charitable organizations to benefit youth in Ashland County.

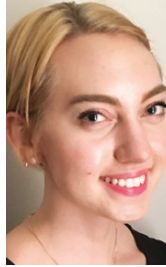

Hess Educational Loans

In 2016-2017, 9 loans totaling \$19,800 were provided to qualifying traditional and non-traditional students pursuing higher education. Since the Foundation's administration of the Fund in 1998, 369 total loans have been awarded. Hess loans have been available since 1923 to Ashland County residents and graduates of Ashland County high schools. \$71,507 is currently in use helping students attend college.



STEM Camp

The Foundation's Honors Science Camp Endowment Fund, created by The Kettering Fund, sponsored the 2017 Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) Camp held at the Ashland County-West Holmes Career Center. This three-day camp in early July engaged over 40 seventh and eighth graders from eight area schools in such activities as an Invasive Species Scavenger Hunt, a study of stream quality through identification of macroinvertebrates, a "Flaming Cheetos Lab" to measure heat and calories produced, an introduction to physics, and demonstrations on electricity and robotics.

Agency Partners

Nonprofit organizations can establish a type of designated, permanently-endowed fund at the Ashland County Community Foundation called an “Agency Fund.” The earning distributions from these endowments provide an ongoing source of income for operations and programs. It’s a simple and efficient way to build an endowment... and help create sustainability...for the organization. This type of endowment also provides the opportunity for the organization to receive planned gifts of various types, including cash, appreciated stock or real estate.

This past year, five new agency funds were established, four of which wish to be publicly acknowledged, to benefit:

1.) Ashland Care Center, 2.) Ashland Christian Health Center, 3.) Ashland Noon Lions Club, in recognition of Eloise Noonan, and 4.) Loudonville-Perrysville School Foundation, Inc.

Ashland Care Center, also known as Ashland Pregnancy Center, provides free, confidential services, including educational programs, in a safe environment for its clients. It is hoped that the establishment of operational endowment will encourage its donors to think long-term in their support.

Ashland Christian Health Center, demonstrated the wisdom of planning for the future, by establishing a new endowment fund at ACCF to provide operational sustainability. This fund was made possible by a gift from a supporter of the organization who wishes anonymity.

Income from the newly-created Ashland Noon Lions Club’s endowment fund, in recognition of Eloise Noonan, the donor who provided the original gift to the club, will provide financial support for sight and vision projects and initiatives, in keeping with the worldwide mission of the Lions Club International.

The Loudonville-Perrysville School Foundation, Inc. established a new agency endowment fund this past year at ACCF to provide long-term operational support, in keeping with its philosophy of sustainability of its grantmaking capability for programs, projects and initiatives that benefit the Loudonville-Perrysville School District.

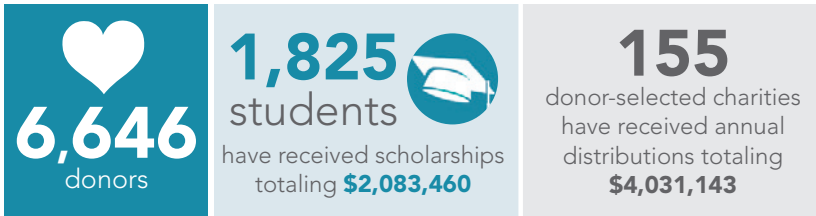

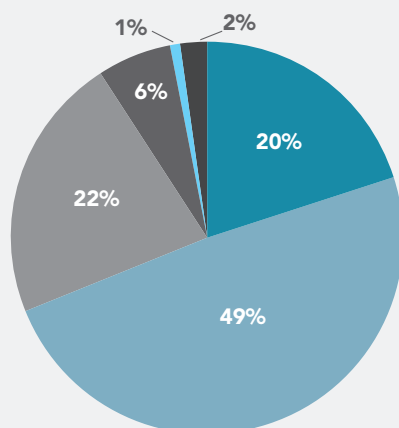
